**VII. INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:**

- A. Teams may move participants from the JV team to the Varsity to fill a void. Example: Injury, sickness, discipline, eligibility, etc. Prior to each competition, including state, rosters would need to be set by dates provided by the CHSAA. Each athlete may only participate at one level within the competitions.
- B. The spirit committee will continue to evaluate the shift and movement in divisions and will discuss combining or splitting based on consistency and recommendations, as well as, other divisions and consider the possibility of splitting when determined necessary by the committee.
- C. The CHSCA Spirit Clinic is mandatory for all 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> year coaches and anyone that has not yet met the coaches safety requirements. Attendance of ALL sessions is required for approval of requirement. Failure to meet this requirement will result in the coach not being allowed to participate at state.
- D. Committee will look at roster minimums and limits for the next cycle in all divisions.
